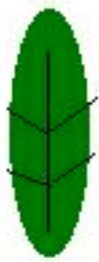
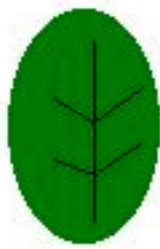


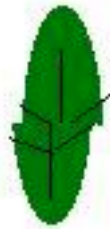

disclosure, revelation

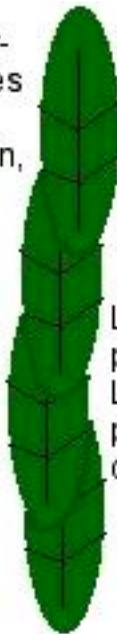


folded over lengthwise

path, direction, momentum

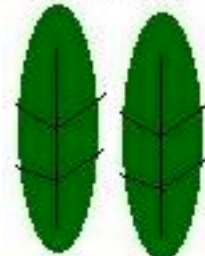


Leaves up = probability.
Leaves down = person unaware of path

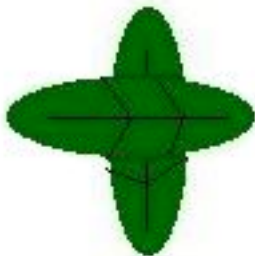


end to end

equivalence



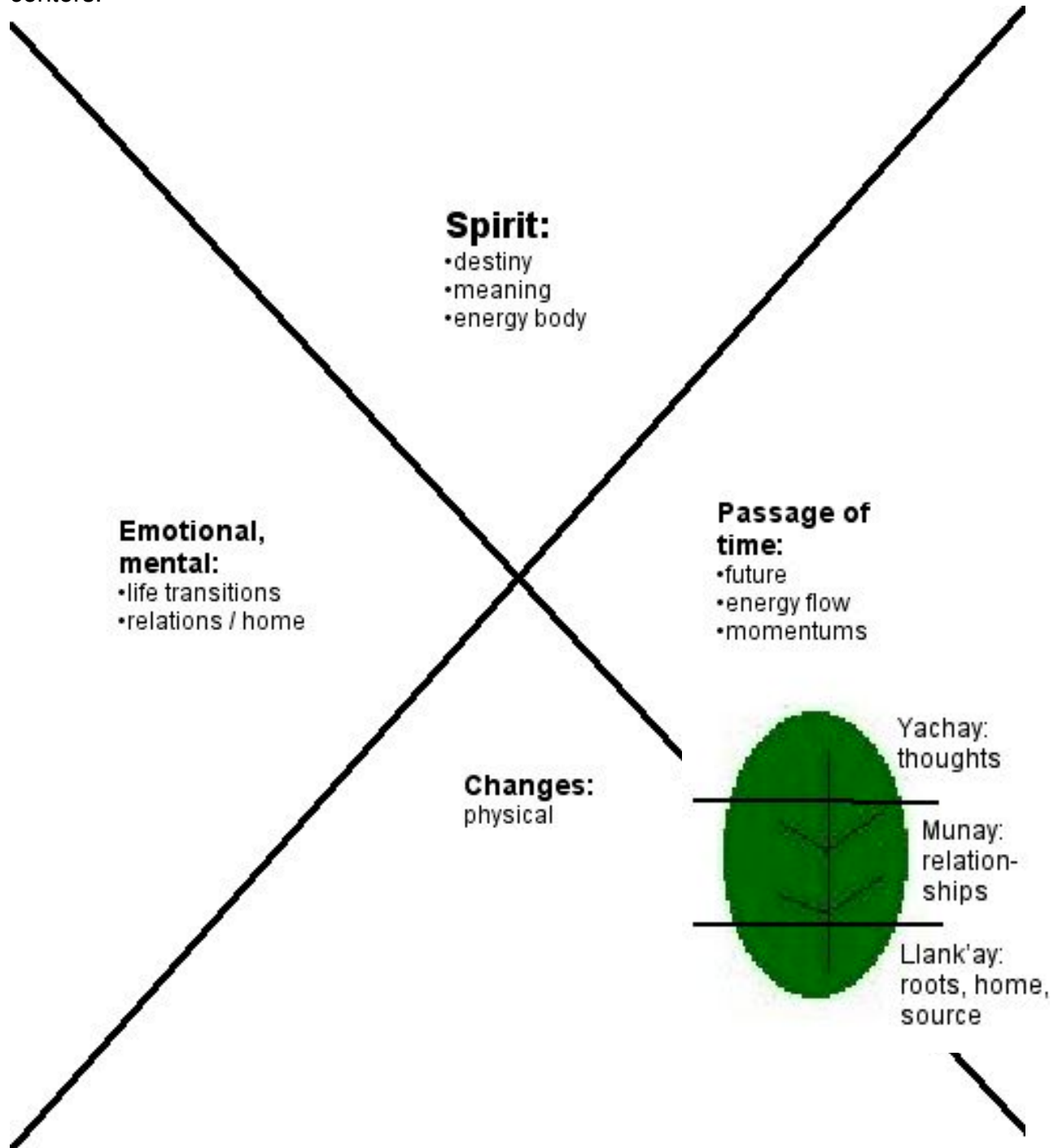
